This unique four-night program offers a rich immersion into Aix-en-Provence and its unique, regional gastronomic offerings. Your stay at the five-star Provençal manor, Le Pignonnet, is complemented by cooking classes, wine tastings, and a visit to a local chocolatier, all whilst uncovering local, architectural gems.

All Passport details should be confirmed at the time of booking. Sales of this program close 90 days prior: book early to avoid disappointment, as space is limited.

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Four nights in Aix-en-Provence: Stay at the five-star Le Pignonnet, an 18th century Provençal manor with gorgeous gardens, once painted by Paul Cezanne. Dine in the restaurant here, which serves Provençal cuisine by celebrated chef Thierry Balligand
- Foodie Experiences: Market and organic vegetable garden tours, visits to a wine merchants, and a local goat cheese maker
- People-to-People Experience: Enjoy a cooking class and lunch at the home of a local chef
- Châteauneuf-du-Pape: Enjoy wine tastings at Domaine de Nalys and Chateau La Nerthe, plus a picnic lunch at Domaine de Nalys , and a visit to Chocolaterie Castelain for wine and chocolate pairings
- Local Experts: Embark on a walking tour of Aix with a local historian, including stops at Cours Mirabeau, the Mazarin area, Judicial Palace, and the Town Hall
- Marvelous Marseilles: Tour the heralded seaside town with visits to Pharo, Notre Dame de la Garde, Vieux Port Ombriere, Le Panier, Le Major Cathedral, and Fort Saint-Jean.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Disembark the ship in Monte Carlo and meet your driver for the transfer to the Nice railway station for your journey Aix-en-Provence. Upon arrival, you'll be met and accompanied to your hotel. Later this afternoon, meet with a local historian and embark on an off-the-beaten-path walking tour of the city. Aix-en-Provence hides invisible treasures, and the architectural heritage helps put the evolution of the city into perspective, as will your guide's narrative as you progress through town, going up the Cours Mirabeau, and visiting the Mazarin area, Judicial Palace, and Town Hall. This evening, enjoy dinner at your hotel.

Day 2

This morning, head out and enjoy a market tour followed by a cooking class. At the market, meet local food producers, and select seasonal ingredients for your menu. Afterwards, set out to the chef's home, stopping along the way at a wine merchant to select wine pairings for your meal, and visit the local goat cheese maker at her ranch. After the short drive, crossing the 17th century Pont des 3 Sautets bridge, painted by Cezanne, you'll arrive at the 12-acre property. After a brief tour of the house and its organic vegetable garden, the cooking commences, with your active participation as you learn new culinary skills over approximately two hours of cooking. After, sit down to dine with chef and your fellow guests and take time to take a walk in the property's wild Provençal Garrigue that's filled with aromatic herbs. This evening, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 3

Today, embark on a full-day excursion to Marseille. Upon arrival, begin your exploration with a visit to the central fish market, and continue on to the Halles de la Major, the nearly 6500 sq. feet of specialty food-makers and growers. Next, it's time for a little sightseeing, starting at the Pharo. The promontory was once a mere rocky plateau, but it's here that Napoleon decided to build "a house at the water's edge;" then on to the famous Notre Dame de la Garde, the Vieux Port Ombrière, Le Panier, Le Major Cathedral, and Fort Saint-Jean. Return to your hotel at the end of the day, where dinner will be served this evening.

Day 4

Another day, another excursion, starting with a visit to Chateauneuf-du-Pape, a village that's almost completely dedicated to its world-famous wine that's part of the Côtes du Rhone family. Visit the Domaine de Nalys, especially renowned for the quality of its white wines, and enjoy a picnic of fresh produce under the olive trees while appreciating breathtaking views of the Dentelles de Montmirail and the mythical Mont Ventoux. After lunch, continue to Château La Nerthe, which has been producing wine since the 12th century, with Certified Organic Farming since 1998. Finish your day by heading to the Chocolaterie Castelain for a chocolate and wine tasting.

Day 5

This morning, after breakfast, you'll be taken to Nice airport for your onward flight.
