DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Your discovery of one of the world's design and fashion capitals begins the moment you're met at Milan airport, with visits to the Duomo, the Castle Sforzesco, and the Scala opera house—the most celebrated opera house in Italy. After lunch at a local restaurant, you'll be transferred to your Lake Como hotel. Check in and relax before dinner at your hotel. The rest of the evening is at your leisure.

Day 2

Travel to Varenna where you'll be joined by a local food connoisseur and town historian. Walking through the commune, your guide will take you "back in time" through the town's monuments, old houses, palaces, streets, courtyards, towers, medieval walls, and churches. Along your way, you'll make stops at local eateries, to mingle with local vendors and learn about their culture and traditions, while sampling some of their most famous specialties, including an aperitif with a tagliere of cured meats and cheeses, risotto and some customary desserts.

Day 3

Take your time with a leisurely breakfast and morning at your hotel before meeting your guide to head to the local pier for an afternoon on Lake Como. Once onboard your boat, sit back, soak up the landscape, and enjoy old family and regional tales as told by your skipper. While onboard you'll also enjoy a gourmet, picnic-style lunch, accompanied by Prosecco. In the later afternoon, you'll be escorted back to your hotel where dinner will be served this evening.

Day 4

After breakfast, you'll be picked by your guide and driven to Venice, making a stop—en route—in Verona for a guided tour of the city, famous for being the setting of Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet. Explore the medieval fortress, ancient Roman ruins, and the famed arena, before stopping at a local restaurant for lunch. You'll then continue onto Venice to board your cruise ship.
