Small in size but grandiose in attitude, Monte Carlo remains a magnet for high rollers and hedonists. Swanky hotels and super yachts dominate this legendary playground where an astonishing 30% of the residents are, in fact, millionaires. Drive through the very streets that host the legendary Monaco Grand Prix and witness the famed Monte Carlo Casino. Later, cross the border into France to visit the medieval village of Eze, where you'll tour a traditional perfumery and soak up panoramic views from high above the Mediterranean. Day three takes you within the ramparts of St. Paul de Vence to discover the artistic masterpieces found within the family-owned Colombe d'Or Hotel.

### HIGHLIGHTS:

- La Condamine Market: Explore this enduring indoor/outdoor market featuring more than 200 shops where locals sell fresh flowers, culinary treats, crafts and more.
- Monte Carlo Casino: Play a few hands of blackjack or roll some dice at the craps table at this historic casino famed for its old-world charm and high-roller attitude.
- Grand Prix Streets: Set a relaxed pace as you drive the very same streets Formula One racers navigate during the legendary Monaco Grand Prix.
- Prince's Palace: Witness the changing of the guard, a time-honored tradition, at this grand palace built in 1191 as a Genoese fortress.
- Larvotto Beach: Just a short walk from downtown Monte Carlo you'll find Monaco's favorite stretch of sand.

- Princess Grace Rose Garden: Take a break from the busy streets at this oasis where thousands of roses blossom, filling the air with their sweet fragrance.
- Museum of Antique Automobiles: Tour this wonder founded by Prince Rainier III and featuring his personal collection of cars, including the Rolls Royce that Grace Kelly rode to the royal wedding.
- Medieval Village of Eze: Drive the scenic roads winding above the Mediterranean to this medieval village perched some 1,400 feet above the turquoise waters. Visit the famed Fragonard Perfume Factory and explore the town's charming cobblestone streets.
- Colombe d'Or Hotel: Marvel at the works of Picasso, Chagall, and Matisse at this legendary family-owned establishment in the town of St. Paul de Vence.

## DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

### Day 1

Debark the ship in Monte Carlo and meet your local guide at the pier. Check into your hotel and enjoy the balance of the day on your own. Monte Carlo is best explored on foot and you'll have plenty of time to stroll along its elegant streets, dotted with designer shops and boutiques. Take a walk along the waterfront where gleaming mega-yachts further Monaco's glamorous charm. Regroup for dinner at the hotel and enjoy the opportunity to get to know your fellow travelers.

### Day 2

Set out to discover the best of Monaco and Monte Carlo. Begin by mingling with the locals at the famed La Condamine Market, a lively collection of flower merchants and fresh culinary markets. Afterwards, drive the famed streets of the Monaco Grand Prix (at a much more leisurely pace, of course) and witness landmarks, including the sensational Monte Carlo Casino. Time permitting, swing by the Prince's Palace to experience the Changing of the Guard, before winding into the mountains to the medieval village of Eze. Take a moment to marvel at the sweeping views of the French Riviera, tour the acclaimed Fragonard Perfume Factory, and enjoy lunch at a charming eatery.

### Day 3

Travel to nearby St. Paul de Vence, a historic town surrounded by great medieval walls for a tour and visit to the iconic Colombe d'Or Hotel. Founded by Paul Roux and still run by his family, the works of Paul's artfully good friends, including Picasso, Matisse, Calder, Braque, and Marc Chagall—who called it home for many years—grace this Provençal charmer. Explore the gardens, dining room, and other chambers for an intimate look at the inspired works of these masters. Afterwards, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Return to your hotel in Monte Carlo by late afternoon and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure.

### Day 4

Following breakfast at the hotel, you'll be escorted to the airport to catch your outbound flight.
