So it's only appropriate that your experience kicks off with a tasting tour of the city. Join a local food critic on a culinary romp that reveals the flavors and foodie heritage of Singapore. You'll also visit a family bakery and a local coffee roasting factory. Plus, meet a master paper artisan who'll provide a fascinating look at this ancestral ritual.

- Singapore Foodie Tour: Join a local food critic for a culinary exploration of the city that includes 10 tasting stops.
- Singapore on Your Own: Enjoy some free time to explore the city, take in the sights, and mingle with the locals on your own.
- Kampong Glam: Explore the historic neighborhood known for its great eateries and dominated by the golden dome of the Sultan Mosque.
- Katong: Visit this vibrant neighborhood, nicely removed from Singapore's more touristy spots, for a true taste of local life.
- Little India: Savor traditional Indian cuisine in this neighborhood dotted with colorful Hindu and Buddhist temples.
- Local Bakery: Learn the secrets of bread making from a 5<sup>th</sup>-generation baker.

- Paper House Making: Meet one of Singapore's master paper house artisans and learn about this Chinese ritual done to honor the dead.

## **DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY**

### **Day 1**

Debark the ship and meet your driver at the pier. Check into your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure. Take advantage of the opportunity to discover Singapore's diverse mix of religious, cultural and historic influences. Find yourself gazing at an inspired Hindu shrine or classic work of colonial architecture moment, only to be wonderfully lost among the gleaming skyscrapers of bustling downtown the next. Use the afternoon for a quick orientation of Singapore before regrouping for a kick-off dinner at the hotel—a great chance to get to know your fellow travelers.

### **Day 2**

Today you'll enjoy an unfiltered and unforgettable taste of Singapore. Join a local food critic and set off on a culinary quest through the city streets. Make your way through the historic Kampong Glam district and wind your way into Singapore's Little India. You'll also explore Katong, a less travelled neighborhood that provides an authentic look at local life. You'll make 10 stops during your tour and savor different tastings at each one, learning about Singapore's culinary history all the while. The rest of the evening will be spent at your leisure.

### **Day 3**

Continue your culinary and cultural quest along the streets of Singapore. Today's first stop is one of the oldest bakeries in the city, where a 5<sup>th</sup>-generation baker will demonstrate the traditional techniques of bread making. Naturally, a tasting is included. Next, meet a master artisan to learn about the Chinese tradition of crafting elaborate paper houses, and why it's believed burning these creations is a way of paying respects to the dead. Finally, visit a local coffee roasting company for a deliciously bold journey led by a coffee connoisseur. Afterwards, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. The rest of the day at your leisure.

### **Day 4**

Following breakfast, enjoy some free time for last-minute shopping or sightseeing before heading to the airport to catch your outbound flight.
